Message from RI President** Rtn. Jennifer Jones RI President 2022-23

On a wooden bench in a small village, I sit with Timothy and his young son Nathan. With a camera crew capturing our conversation, he tells me of the time Nathan showed signs of malaria. He brought the boy to the nearby home of a community health worker, where Nathan quickly received medicines that in all likelihood saved his life.

Calmly, Timothy tells me about his other son's bout with the disease a few years earlier. He had to race that son to a medical clinic more than 5 miles away. Riding a bike and carrying his child on his back, he tells me, he could feel his son's legs turn cold and then his little body go limp. As he finally entered the clinic, he screamed for help, but it was too late. The camera stops rolling, and we sit in silence. He begins to weep, and I hold him tightly. "I lost my son, I lost my son," he says.

This story is all too familiar for the families we meet over the next few days. And yet there is hope. Partners for a Malaria-Free Zambia is Rotary's first Programs of Scale grant recipient, and it is saving lives. Across two provinces of Zambia, 2,500 volunteer health workers have been selected by their communities. They are trained to bring medical care closer to those who need it, and they are able to diagnose and treat malaria and other ailments. Rotary partnerships create lasting change.

4th December: Free Medical Camp with RCC Sadhukhardari Welfare Society, Usthi

Rotary Club of Calcutta Avyanna along with its RCC Shadhukhardari Rural Welfare Society, held a free medical camp for the locals in Usthi. The camp involved Free check-up of Blood Pressure, random Blood Sugar and Blood Groups tests, for inhabitants of the village. As many as, 72 villagers had their Blood Pressure checked and 58 Blood Sugar samples were drawn on that day. The idea behind the Camp was to capture potential patients and help them take due precaution in advance. A first-hand review of this extremely interior settlement revealed that largely, the villagers were not aware of the consequences of these lethal diseases. The importance of being aware of their Blood Group was also explained to them by the Club Members. A team of seven technicians and volunteers were present, along with 9 Club Members.

About 80, mostly women, had their BP, ECG & Blood Sugar tested. The Club members explained to them the importance of regular health check-up. ECG was also conducted for both the men and women attendees. RC of Cal Avyanna, distributed 50 blankets to elderly women at the Shyamnagar RCC center, under the Club's Avyannadaan, initiative. It was very gratifying for the Members to see the elderly ladies so happy.

19th December: Menstrual Hygiene Workshop

Rotary Club of Calcutta Avyanna conducted a menstrual hygiene workshop at Christopher Road Government sponsored Higher Secondary School for girls. Around 60 students attended the workshop and greatly benefited from it. A PPT presentation of the Do's and Don'ts to be followed during periods; how to maintain hygiene was discussed. An interactive session on general awareness of diets to be followed and exercise as well as lifestyle was talked about. The students asked a lot of questions regarding certain taboos and restrictions that they have been asked to follow during the menstrual periods. Club Member Mandira Mukherjee explained to them the meaninglessness of it all. She also reinstated the importance of hygiene and of maintaining their regular lifestyle during periods and to use sanitary napkin. The scientific explanation of the whole process enlightened the girls. A packet of sanitary napkin was given to each girl by the Club.

















24th December:

Interactors Organise a Medical Camp

Interact Club of Birla Bharati organized a Medical Camp at Remedy Clinic in association with Milan Tirtha Club. The medical camp was based on free checkup of Blood Pressure and Weight of underprivileged patients. Recognised physiotherapist, Debashish Roy checked patients having arthritis and prescribed medicines. Rtn. Dr. Sudipta Chandra, ENT Specialist checked patients too. Total footfall was around 120. Rotarians and Interactors gave shawls and thermal vests to underprivileged families at the Camp. 9 volunteers from Birla Bharati Interact Club were present and helped in distribution of 25 shawls and 15 thermal vests. 5 shawls and 5 vests were distributed to the underprivileged roadside people at a Masjid at the Prince Anwar Shah connector.
